The Staff at the Brian Young High School Team Camp & Soccer Combine is pleased to invite you to participate in an opportunity to further your chances to play collegiate soccer and gain maximum exposure to top collegiate coaches. In the past, coaches from St. Edward's University (TX), Bryant University, Salve Regina, Johnson & Wales, Brown University, Providence College, Rhode Island College, & Newbury College were present and coached at the Brian Young High School Team Camp. The combine returns again this year from July 26-29th, 2010 at the soccer fields at Winslow Fields in Warwick, RI. **Last year's team camp & combine sold out early so please make sure you get your registration in early.**

The camp is designed to offer instruction and exposure to soccer players approaching entrance to a four year university soccer program. It will consist of four days of instruction and conditioning for the players while our objective is to prepare the players (technically and physically) for their 2010 upcoming high school season. Campers will be divided into teams and assigned a coach from an attending collegiate soccer program. These teams will spend time with their coach learning what they and other college coaches will be looking for during the week and in the future. The teams will then compete in small sided and full sided games while being coached by the attending college coaches.

The camp is open to male and female soccer players, 13 years of age or older, but is intended primarily for high school incoming freshman, sophomores, juniors and seniors or current junior college players. Campers will provide contact information as well as academic information that will be distributed to the college coaches.

PARTICIPANT WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS FORM BRIAN YOUNG SOCCER CAMPS

1. In consideration for receiving permission to participate in Brian Young Soccer Camp, which is sponsored by the Warwick Fire Fighters, I hereby RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS, Sponsor, Brian Young, Donald Denham and their respective officers, trustees, agents, employees, servants and volunteers (collectively, the "Released Parties") FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL MANNER OF ACTIONS, CAUSES OF ACTION, SUITS, AND CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR OTHER DAMAGE OR LOSS (collectively "Losses"), that result from or arise in connection with my participation in the Activity, or that occur while I am on the premises owned or leased by any Released Party, **including Losses resulting from the negligence of any RELEASED PARTY.** I understand the playing of soccer may involve physically strenuous activities. I know of no medical reason why I should not participate.
2. I am fully aware that there are inherent risks involved with soccer playing, including but not limited to all manner of physical injuries such as, head trauma and bone fractures as a result of playing soccer and other more serious injuries and I choose to voluntarily participate in the playing of soccer with full knowledge that said soccer playing may be hazardous to me and my property. **I VOLUNTARILY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISKS OF LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH,** that may be sustained by me as a result of participating in the playing of soccer **including injuries sustained as a result of the negligence of any RELEASED PARTY.** I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the RELEASED PARTIES for any loss, liability, damage or costs, including court costs and attorney's fees that may occur as a result of my participation in the playing of soccer.
3. I am aware that I should review my personal insurance coverage with respect to the risks I am assuming in connection with the playing of soccer.
4. It is my express intent that this Covenant Not to Sue and Agreement to Hold Harmless shall bind the members of my family, if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, if I am deceased, and shall be governed by the laws of the State of RI.
5. In signing this Covenant Not to Sue and Agreement to Hold Harmless, I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing Covenant Not to Sue and Agreement to Hold Harmless, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed; no oral representations, statements, or inducements apart from the foregoing agreement that has been reduced to writing have been made.
